AUTO THEFT PREVENTION TIPS

- Remove your keys from the ignition and vehicle after every use.
- Lock your vehicle, no matter where you are.
- Do not leave your keys in your car while warming it up on cold mornings, or at the gas station or convenience store, or while dropping off the kids at day-care, etc. Do not hide a key in or on your vehicle. Thieves break into cars searching for keys.
- Do not leave your purse, wallet, title, or registration in your vehicle. Auto thieves are also frequently fraud, forgery, and identity theft offenders.
- Keep your title someplace safe and secure.
- Carry your registration in your purse or wallet. If your vehicle is stolen, you will have the necessary reporting information and the thief won't know your name and address.
- Do not hide or keep a firearm in your vehicle.
