- b) AYC Book Discussion Members discussed the final reading of *The 7 Habits of Highly Effective Teens* and subjects they found insightful and relatable. Everyone agreed the book discussion was worthwhile.
- c) AYC will recess for the summer and resume for school year 2019/2020 on Thursday, August 1st. All members are encouraged to recruit new youth members over the break. If current members return and members whose terms are expiring re-apply, there will be two youth vacancies and no adult vacancies.
