


DISCUSSION	Dearman stated that Police entry-level applications were open from March 11th through April 4 th to help fill the June academy with people from the last list. She added that 253 applications were submitted, and 217 applicants passed MQ screening and were invited to schedule for the Frontline exam. She stated that 77 people are now on the certification list.

B. Extension of Police Lieutenant Certification List		Shuman
DISCUSSION	Shuman asked the Commission to consider extending the 2020 police lieutenant for 90 days, which would push the new testing into next year. She stated that it was for budgetary reasons. She added that there were enough people left on the list to move forward. She stated that she had already checked with Chief Wilson who was on board.
