- B. Update from the Chair Paula spoke on attending the Colorado Association of Libraries (CAL) where Midori and her team were awarded the Project of the Year for the Aurora Scholars program which was brought inside the Library for the first time.
- C. Miscellaneous –Aurora Public Library's celebration of Hispanic Heritage month started on Oct. 6 with an evening of two art exhibits; *Calacas Art Exchange Project* produced in partnership with Denver Botanic Gardens and *Pride on Your Side* a photography exhibit by documentary artist Juan Fuentes in partnership with the Boulder Museum of Contemporary Art (BMoCA).

VIII. ITEMS FROM THE DIRECTOR

A. General Update – Aurora Public Libraries and Central especially, have seen an increase in use (checkouts). Checkouts are nearly at pre-COVID numbers; up 11% overall checkouts from last year. Central is up nearly 56%, MLK is up 6%, Mission Viejo is up 18% and Hoffman is up 30%. Electronic circulation is up 20%. Library visits are not at pre-COVID numbers, but people are accessing materials and services.

Follow-up: Karen will print out statistics and comment cards for Library Board meetings beginning with the December 2022 meeting.

B. Programming Update – Staff voted on a theme for 2023 and selected *Reimagine Aurora Public Library*. There will be many events and a logo to go along with the theme. The Grand Opening of the Chambers Plaza Library will be in January 2023 and the Grand Opening of the Bookmobile will be in February. The Library will be producing a limited edition 2023 library card and going fine-free in January. Two branches will be expanding hours; Central Library and Tallyn's Reach (Tues.-Thurs., 9 a.m. – 8 p.m. and Fri.-Sun., 10 a.m. – 6 p.m.).
