WHEREAS, current and former members of our Armed Forces have sworn an oath to support and defend the Constitution of the United State against all enemies foreign and domestic; and,


WHEREAS, current and former members of our Armed Forces have guaranteed their oath with their lives, liberty, and honor; and,
