Connection Fees

City of Aurora Connection Fees consist of three components: 1) Water Service Connection Fee, 2) City of Aurora Sanitary Sewer Connection Fee and 3) Metro Wastewater District Connection Fee. The total connection fee is the sum of all three components. The calculation of connection fees is specified by user class. The user classes are Single Family Residential Detached, Single Family Residential Attached, Multi-Family Residential, and Commercial (all other non-residential uses). Regardless of assessment, all fees are due at the rate in effect at the time of payment.
